CRITERIA FOR APPROVING REQUEST FOR PERMANENT USEFUL INFRASTRUCTURE TO BE INSTALLED ON SOUTHPORT GOLF CLUB COURSE AS RECOGNITION FOR DECEASED MEMBERS.

() Extraordinary contribution either Financial or Personal.
() Displayed credibility, Integrity and respect of fellow Club members.
() Outstanding inspirational volunteer who has, over a long period of time, become a role model and encouraged the development of golf at the Club particularly with our juniors.
() Displayed exceptional leadership as a Board member or Committee member and continued to maintain a mentoring and leadership role over a period of time.
() Through initiative and skills as a volunteer and a committed club member, managed fund raising and campaigns to bring revenue to the Club and support the Community in times of need.
() Outstanding support to our Club in promoting the Club with the general Community resulting in increased membership. Is seen as an effective ambassador for the Club.
() Through innovation and creativity, has developed programs to deal with the ever-changing environment within the Golfing Community. Recognised as adding value. Ongoing involvement over a long period of time.
() Outstanding volunteer work in a number of areas which may not involve golf, but, provide advice and hands-on support over a long period of time.
() No monetary or personal gains received for volunteer work.

In considering any request, a majority of the above criteria should be applicable.
