

## PROCEDURE IN CASE OF INCORRECT SCORING ADVISED BY WAY OF COMPLAINT

In first instance written advices are referred to a sub-committee of members from Match and Course Committee (which will include as a minimum the Club Captain and General Manager).

If either or both the Player and Marker are accused of knowingly recording incorrect scores, either or both will be requested to attend a meeting of the sub-committee.

If it is established that incorrect scores by either the player and/or marker have been knowingly submitted, either the player and marker, or both, are disqualified from the event in accordance with Rules of Golf.

As a result of this investigation, if the recording of incorrect scores was intentional (Cheating), the matter should then be referred to the Board for action to be commenced against the player or marker or both, in accordance with Rule 15 of the Constitution.
