

TEMPORARY LOCAL RULES

From the 25th October to 30th November 2025, until further notice, the Temporary Local Rules have been adjusted to accommodate for renovations.

Preferred Lies (General Area)

When a player's ball lies in the general area, one scorecard length free relief from where the original ball lies, no nearer the hole, is permitted using the same or a substituted ball. The ball may only be placed once, per stroke, in the relief area.

The ball must be placed as outlined under Rule 14.2b(2). If the ball will not come to rest, in taking a preferred lie, after two attempts, relief may be taken under Rule 14.2e by placing the ball in the nearest spot where the ball will come to rest in the general area.

After a ball has been placed and is in play under this Local Rule, if the player then proceeds under another Rule that provides relief, this Local Rule may be used again.

Preferred Lies (Ball on Putting Green)

If a player's ball lies in or touches an aeration hole on the putting green, the player may take free relief under Rule 16.1d, by replacing the original ball within one scorecard length, no nearer the hole, either on or off the green.

Interference does not exist if the aeration hole only interferes with the player's stance or area of intended swing or on the player's line of play.

Penalty for Playing Ball from a Wrong Place in Breach of Local Rule:

General Penalty (2 strokes) Under Rule 14.7a
