

TEMPORARY LOCAL RULES ABNORMAL COURSE CONDITIONS

Effective: 22nd November 2025

CONSTRUCTION ZONE 15 HOLE:

The Construction Zone at the rear of the 15th Temporary Green, beyond the white line, is declared a No Play Zone (NPZ).

If a player's ball comes to rest on or beyond the white line, free relief must be taken.

- If a player's ball lies in/on such NPZ, or
- If the NPZ interferes with a player's stance or swing;

Free relief must be taken at the nearest available Drop Zone.

BARE OR DEAD PATCHES ON ALL GREENS:

The repaired/bare/dead patches on any affected green are declared as Abnormal Course Conditions (ACC).

- If a player's ball lies on such ACC, or
- The ACC interferes with a player's line of play (Not Stance);

free relief may be taken in accordance with Rule 16.1d.

Therefore:-

If a player's ball is on the putting green and there is interference by such abnormal course condition, the player may take free relief by placing the original ball or another ball on the spot of the nearest point of complete relief.

- The nearest point of complete relief must be either on the putting green or in the general area.
- If there is no such nearest point of complete relief, the player may still take this free relief by using the point of maximum available relief as the reference point, which must be either on the putting green or in the general area.

TREE ROOT REMOVAL (REPAIRS AND UNFILLED HOLES):

Any unfilled holes resulting from Tree Root removal or Stump Grinding are declared as GUR.

All areas where tree roots or stumps were removed and filled with sand (Not Divots) are declared as GUR.

If a plyers ball comes to rest in or on any such area, or such area interferes with a player's stance or swing, a player is entitled to free relief under Rule 16.1.

Relief Area:

Within one club length of the nearest point of relief, no nearer the hole. The ball must be dropped in and come to rest in the relief area.
