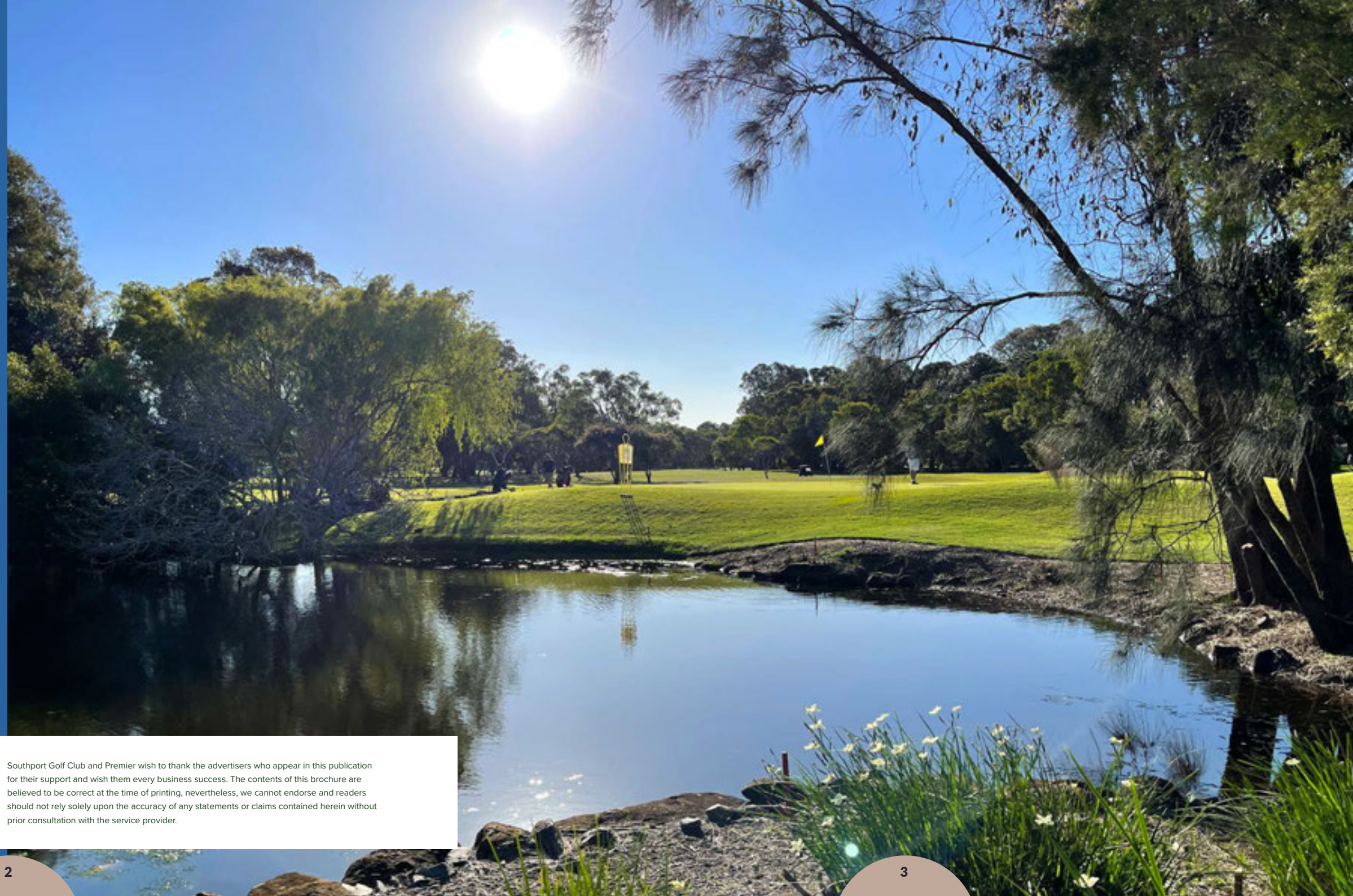

A BREIF HISTORY

Now a thriving golf course in the centre of upmarket residential areas on the outskirts of Southport and Surfers Paradise, it is hard to imagine that there was once a peaceful dairy farm on the land occupied by Southport Golf Club.



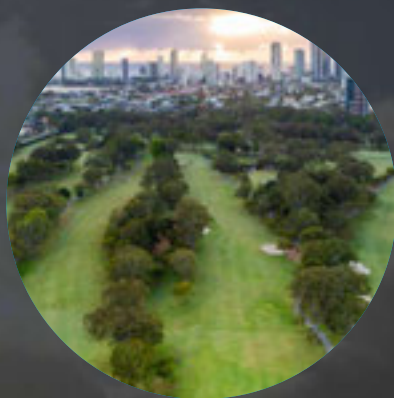
South Coast Recreations bought the land from Mr Holden, a local dairy farmer, whose son later worked for many years as a groundsman on the course. It was not only to be used for golf but formed part of a complex that included a cinema and hotel.

The first club was formed in 1924 after a special meeting. Initial membership was 95, who played a nine-hole course.

It was not until 1937 that the Greater Southport Golf Club came into being. This in turn became Southport Golf Club in 1952.

Club Captain at the time, Mr E F Doyle, had much to do with development of the 18-hole course, which was first played in 1948.

Over the intervening period, substantial investment has been made in honing and refining the layout to ensure it remains as good as any to be found on the Gold Coast.



The Club has been equally committed to offering its members a desirable haven to spend time off the course.

The current clubhouse has been built at a cost of \$2.3m and was officially opened in 1995. Internal refurbishments and improvements including the addition of a new kitchen and an alfresco dining area known as the Terrace have been completed recently.

The course has been maintained to the highest standards, not all of it of a golfing nature.

Famed Queensland aviator Bert Hinkler landed his Avro aircraft near the first tee in September 1928 during difficult flying conditions!

It is golf, however, which has put Southport on the map. The Club has produced many wonderful players, arguably none finer than Anne Alletson (née Nunn).

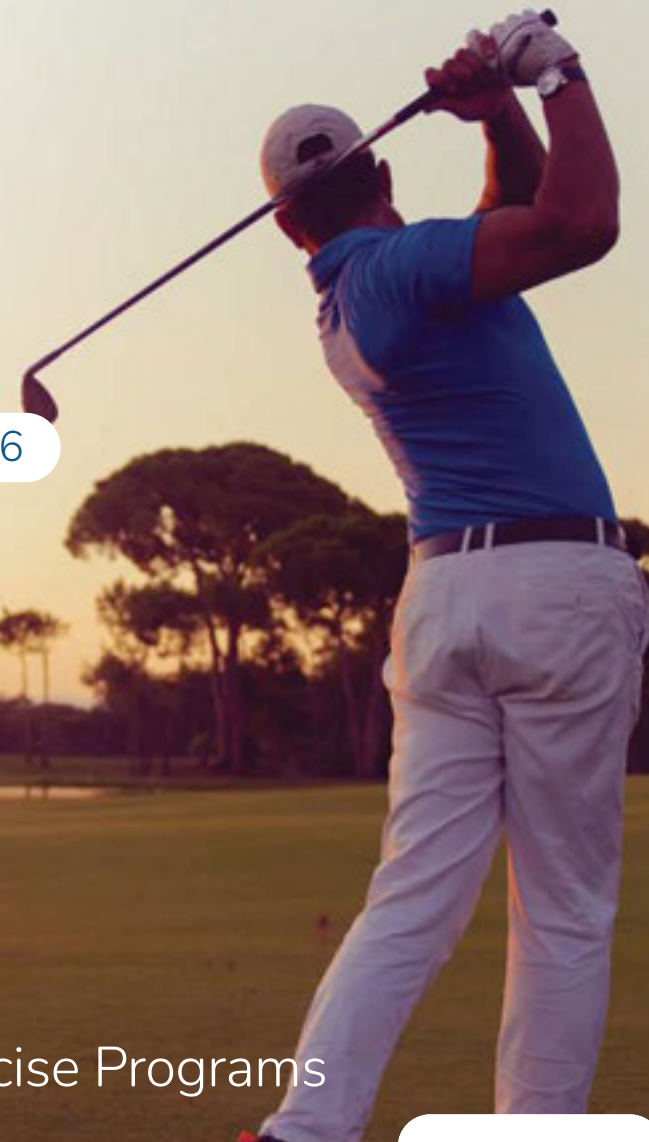

Anne represented Queensland and Australia in both interstate and international tournaments. She was Queensland junior champion in 1962, Queensland Open champion in 1973 and 1976 and runner-up in the Australian Championships in 1975.

As captain of the old coast team, Anne was the first to hit off in the inaugural Meg Nunn Salver, the tournament named after her mother.

The club has a proud record of developing exceptional junior players. Tod Power became Australian Schoolboys' Champion in 1981 and was once joint oldest to hit the course record, while former Southport junior and club champion, Simon Moore won the Australian Amateur Championships.

Stuart Bouvier became the youngest Club champion when he won the 1985 championships at just 15 years of age.

After 100 years it is debatable whether any member, past, present or future, can match the golfing year enjoyed by Philip Soegaard in 1990 when he took out the Club championships, two national titles, four state titles and 14 other tournament wins.

Why not come and make your own golfing history? The next exciting chapter in Southport Golf Club's golfing dynasty is just waiting to be written.

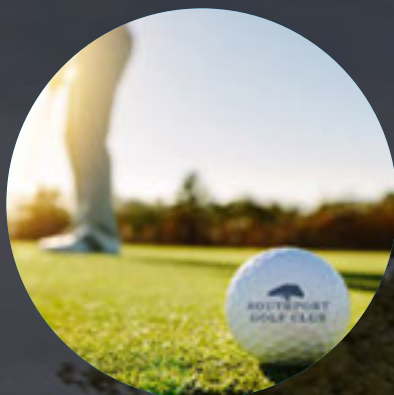

THE SOUTHPORT COURSE

The focus of Southport Golf Club is to provide an outstandingly presented golf course and facilities for the enjoyment of our members and their guests.



Recognition for these efforts has come on numerous occasions with the Club being chosen to host many championship events in its 100 year history.

Most recently, Southport was honoured to host the Australian Boys Amateur Championships, the Queensland Strokeplay Championship and Queensland Amateur Matchplay Championship.

The 18-hole layout is a par 71 for the men, measuring 5,816 metres. The ladies enjoy an equally invigorating test, featuring a 5,312-metre par-73 layout, benefiting from an extra shot on two of the toughest par-4 holes for the men, the 9th and 17th.

The course is easy walking with a mild amount of undulation with tree-lined fairways and strategically placed ponds and lakes.

The trees on the course are varied, as are the birds and wildlife. Water dragons can be seen sunning themselves on the banks of the water catchment areas and members have their favourite turtles, which come up to be fed.

It's a place for the bird-lover and the birdie-lover too, providing you exercise the grey matter. Southport is not long by today's standards, but that does not make it any less of a challenge, rewarding brains over brawn.

Commonly described as "thinking golfer's course", this layout rewards the few who can strategically play the hole instead of the player who automatically reaches for driver off the tee on anything but the par-3s.

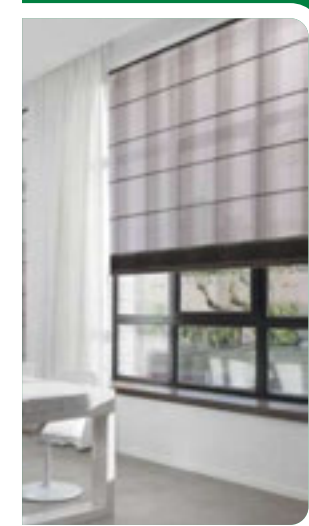
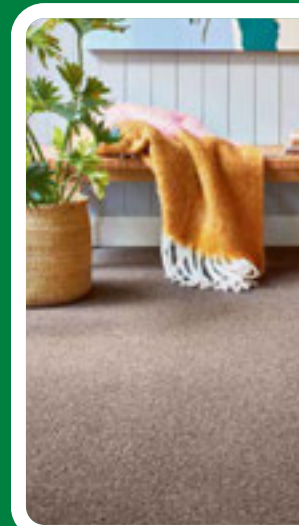
First-time visitors often remark about the appearance of the fairways, which are beautifully manicured and green, and the true-rolling nature of the greens, which are a delight to putt on.

The greens are 328 couch grass and roll consistently with a Stimpmeter reading of between 9 and 10 feet.

The course starts with the newly refurbished par 5 1st hole. Most golfers meander through the first nine holes comfortably.

The back nine where the games are fought with "amen" corner commencing with the par 3, 14th hole. With two of the toughest holes on the card coming at 17 and 18, championships and pennant matches are even considered as coming down the closing stretch.

THE SOUTHPORT COURSE TOUR

We hope you enjoy your time with us at Southport Golf Club. Here are a few useful tips and course notes which should help you make the most of your round if you have never visited us before. Distances shown are from the blue tees.

Hole 1, 445 metres, par 5

The perfect hole to start any round, the 1st hole is the easiest on the course and provides a very good start with a great chance to get off to a good start. A good drive down the right side of the fairway will leave many golfers with the chance to hole out on this reachable par 5.



Hole 2, 153 metres, par 3

This gorgeous par 3 allows a range of shots to be played depending on the tee and pin position on the day. The green is heavily bunkered with deep bunkers to the front right and left of the green. Smart play is rewarded here, forget the pin and aim for the heart of the green.

Hole 3, 352 metres, par 4

One of the shorter par 4s on the course, with placement off the tee crucial. This tricky hole can lead to some challenging shots where you can be required to shape the ball either way. Exercise caution when selecting your club on the tee. The fairway bunkers on the right side encourage the use of a longer club, but a longer club will bring the water on the left side well into play. Be smart and take a long iron or utility off the tee, aiming for the centre of the fairway. You will be left with a short iron into this guarded green. Four here is always a good score.

Hole 4, 381 metres, par 4

This longer dog leg right par 4 appears easy enough but looks can be deceiving! A good drive here is needed down the right side for the best approach shot into the recently refurbished green. The longer hitters will have to bite off part of the dog leg or will quickly run out of room on the left side. Leaving yourself with an uphill putt is your best chance for a three!

Hole 5, 476 metres, par 5

This short par five is another good chance for birdie. The dog leg right encourages the longer hitters to take on the corner, offering a better chance to reach the green with the second shot. Water on the left and out of bounds right claim a few victims with wayward second shots. The heart of the green is the place to find with your approach. Any putt from the centre of the green has a realistic chance.

Hole 6, 330 metres, par 4

This short par 4 can cause trouble for the unsuspecting! The perfect tee shot here will find the left side of the fairway giving the perfect angle of attack into this narrow green. It is the approach shot here that can bring things undone! The right side of the green is icely guarded by a deep bunker, while the left side drops away into tricky grassy swales. A tough up and down if the green is missed either side.

Hole 7, 127 metres, par 3

All golfers will only require a short iron into this green. It is the best par 3 birdie opportunity on the course, though that's not to say that it is guaranteed! The green is surrounded by bunkers and makes the tee shot that little more daunting. The real trouble starts when the strong south-easterly picks up, making this green look like a postage stamp.

Hole 8, 479 metres, par 5

A good three-shot par 5. The double dog leg doesn't allow you to feel safe over any shot. The longer hitters need to carry the corner on the right side with the driver risk unningo into the room to the left. The best play for your second is to carry the big tree on the left side of the fairway leaving you with a short iron into this large green. This hole is not a realistic eagle opportunity for even the really big hitters. The green is guarded at the front with water both left and right. Be careful or your score card may receive some damage.

Hole 9, 386 metres, par 4 (Ladies' par 5)

This challenging par 4 is a good finishing hole for the front nine. The tee shot requires concentration with heavy tree lines down both sides of the fairway. Even after a good drive the approach shot into this undulating green is somewhat daunting. As with many of the other holes on the front 9, the green is guarded by a risky bunker situated to the right of the green. The middle of the green is the safest place to be, no matter where the pin is.

Hole 10, 316 metres, par 4

This short par 4 eases you into the much tougher back nine. This dog leg right is fairly straight forward. The big hitters often try to drive the green by carrying the tree line on the right side. The safer option is to take a long iron off the tee and leave yourself with a wedge for your approach.

Hole 11, 341 metres, par 4

This tight dog leg right is a tough driving hole. The length of the hole has water left and out of bounds right, with a large gum kindly placed on the edge of the fairway to make you really think! The best play for the better players is to take your drive over the large gum giving you a good approach into this tough green. For the majority of golfers, though, a 3 wood moving left to right is the ideal shot off the tee. The green is one of the most dangerous on the course so make sure you leave your approach below the hole. Anything above the hole is a treacherous downhill putt.

Hole 12, 184 metres, par 3

This long uphill par 3 is by far the toughest par 3 on the course. The tee shot requires great accuracy with a long iron needed to find this tricky green. The green has a massive bunker guarding the front left and a smaller one on the right. This long and narrow green makes for very interesting play.

Hole 13, 452 metres, par 5

One of the signature holes of the course and offers a true test of “risk versus reward”. The tee shot here depends on how confident you are with your driver as the water on the right-hand side of the fairway is 220 metres from this elevated tee. If you are confident, play your driver down the left side of the fairway flirting with the water, giving yourself a chance of reaching the green in two. If you have any doubts, leave it in the bag for a few more holes yet and play it safe with a rescue wood or long iron off the tee and mid iron for your second, leaving you with a short iron for your approach to the green.



Hole 14, 159 metres, par 3

The 14th is a picturesque par 3 that requires a mid iron. Solid contact is a must with your tee shot. The water that covers the right side of the hole tends to be fairly attractive to most golfers. So unless you feel like a swim, take aim at the centre of the green.

Hole 15, 318 metres, par 4

This short par 4 is a great test of golf and starts to put a little heat on for the home stretch. The tee shot has a small landing area no matter what your club of choice. The dog leg left has water blanketing the left of the fairway with a dense tree line to the right. The safest play is a longer iron from the tee to the right side of the fairway. This will leave you with a mid iron approach into this narrow green.

Hole 16, 169 metres, par 3

A good tee shot is generously rewarded, with anything on the green having a realistic chance of birdie. The surrounds on this hole make it tough to get up and down. There is a large bunker on the right and rough to the left of the green. Play smart coming down the home stretch!

Hole 17, 383 metres, par 4 (Ladies' par 5)

This hole is the hardest hole on the course and deservedly so. This long par 4 is intimidating from the moment you stand on the tee. The tee box is tucked in amongst some tall pine trees restricting how far right you can take your drive. The tee shot for the better golfers requires a good drive down the right side carrying the fairway bunkers. Anything left of the bunkers will more than likely roll into the water which is somewhat obscured from the tee. Most golfers should just aim to leave their tee shot in 150 metres from the green in the middle of the fairway. The large green is protected by water at the front which makes the approach shot a little shaky, especially if you still have a longer iron in your hands. Your approach shot needs the correct club for distance, as there is plenty of room there for a three putt.

Hole 18, 365 metres, par 4

This tight par 4 is a challenge for every golfer. The perfect happens a slight draw off the tee. The first fairway bunker located on the right side of the fairway is 215 metres from the tee whilst the second bunker is located 256 metres from the tee, hence the closer you are to the green the more difficult it is. The approach into the green is intimidating with an elevated two-tier green. Anything to the left will catch a well-placed trap, making it tough to save four. Anything to the right will catch the tricky undulating swales, making it just as tough. Leaving yourself with an uphill putt is ideal.

Southport Golf Club has a wonderful championship course. Wouldn't it be nice to have a golf game to match and to be able to enjoy this layout to the full?

You could admire the beauty of the course's flora and fauna and water features from the centre of the fairway instead of up close and personal and a visit to the greenside bunkers might no longer be a thing to fear. 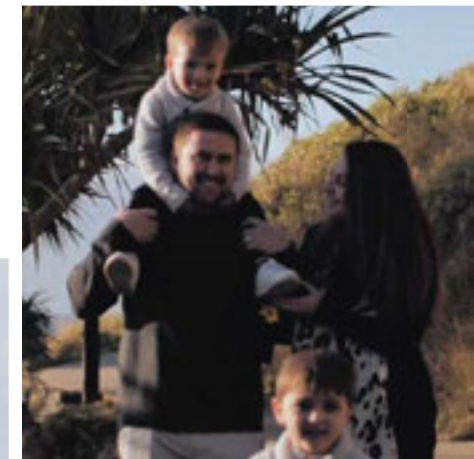

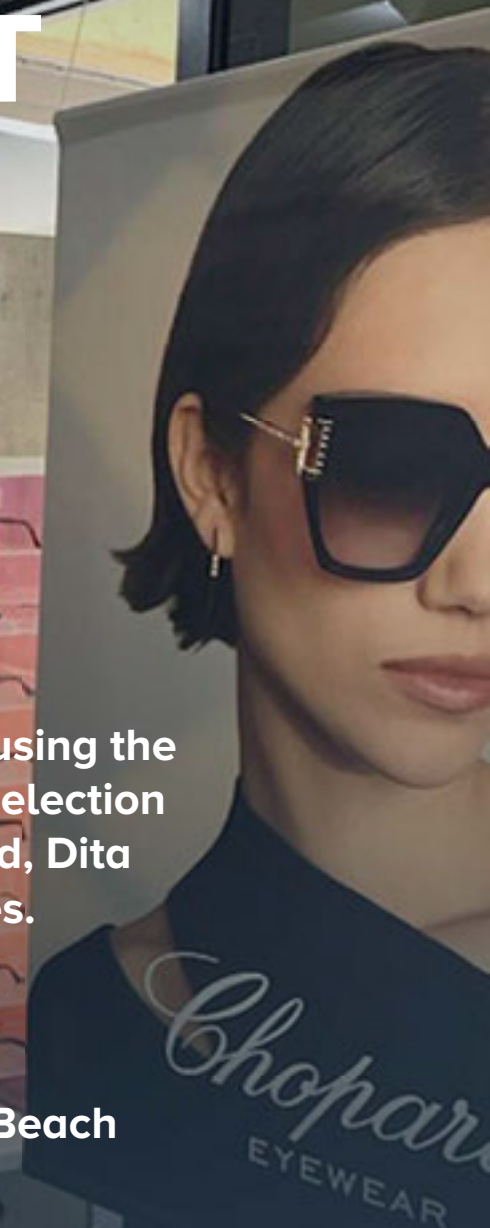

OUR MEMBERS' GOLF

Members at Southport Golf Club love their golf and can look forward to a full golfing calendar offering a great range of events throughout the season.



There is interclub play, prestigious competitions where the winners get to ink their names in the Club's history books as well as more light-hearted and social play where the top priority is simply to enjoy the game in good company.

For excitement, it's hard to beat interclub golf, with clubs around the Gold Coast all eager to test themselves against their peers.

The men enter a team in the top division of the pennant competition run by the Gold Coast District Golf Association.

Don't think, though, that it is only the scratch golfers who have the opportunity and honour of representing Southport Golf Club. With sides also fielded in all three divisions of the Interclub pennant (which have prescribed minimum handicap limits), everyone can experience the thrill that interclub golf can bring.

The women enjoy similar exciting competition against other clubs, entering a weekend Pennant team and another six teams in the Midweek Pennant.

Age is no barrier to enjoying good golf, either. For men aged 50 and over there is the Seniors Pennant, which follows the traditional pennants format. Then there's the Super Senior Pennants, aimed at golfers aged 60 or over who still crave their annual interclub fix.

With few openings for green-fee-paying visitors to play and no corporate golf days at Southport Golf Club, it means tee times are always prioritised for members, who are offered more opportunities to play than is the case at most other clubs.

The Club calendar features prestigious Honour Board events such as the Club Championship. These honour boards, dating back decades, adorn the clubhouse walls. There are also the traditional monthly medals or Stableford competitions that offer the chance to make many new friends.

Men and women enjoy dedicated competition days with reserved tee times and opportunities to play together in joint fields.

Competitions take place for men on Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday and on Wednesday, Friday and Saturday for women. There are medley competitions on Friday and Sunday, with social play on Mondays and after 3pm most days.

There are many relaxed and fun competitions throughout the season, including charity days raising money for local good causes which highlights the generous nature of the Club's diverse membership.

Southport Golf Club hosts several feature golf events during the season which are open to members and players from other clubs.

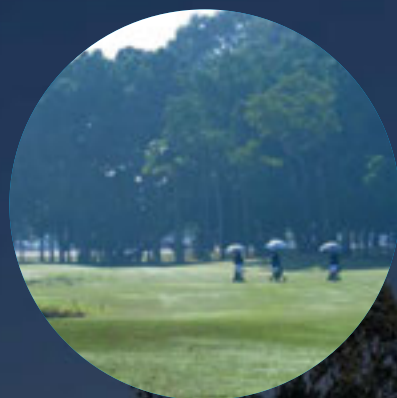


These tournaments always receive wonderful support, are well received by the participants and give the Club the chance to showcase its excellent facilities to a wider audience.

Off the lounge is a separate Sports Bar to showcase all the season's live sporting events with seating for 24 diners.

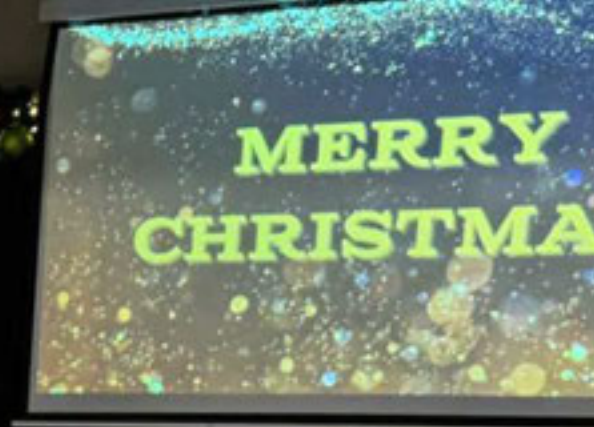

Southport Golf Club offers the perfect venue for corporate meetings, company functions, intimate meals or other special occasions.



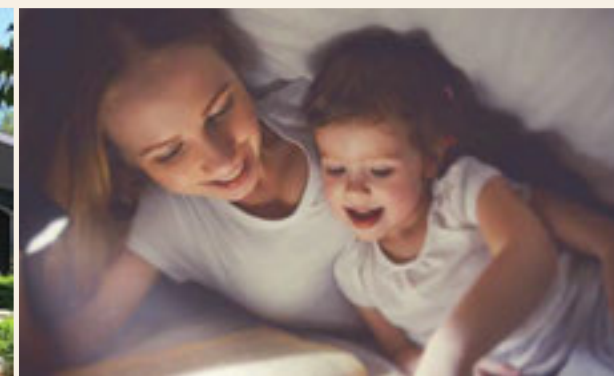
